Pastry/Patisserie

The level 2 Diploma in Food Preparation and Culinary Art – Patisserie (Pastry) 8064-02 is for candidates who wish to work in the hospitality industry and specialise in Patisserie (Pastry). They will have the knowledge of the basic principles of kitchen work as the candidate must first complete Level 2 Diploma in Food Preparation and Culinary Arts 8064-01.

The candidate will be required to display both practical skills and the associated knowledge in order to complete the assessments. This qualification covers food safety and safety at work and the preparation, cooking and finishing of a wide range of patisserie products. On completion of this qualification candidates can progress into employment or complete: Level 3 City & Guilds Advanced Diploma in Culinary Arts and Supervision (8064-06)
